What is flaring?

Coalbed gas (CBG), like conventional natural gas projects, requires some flaring during well testing and for a brief time during the start-up of a well when the gas contains too much nitrogen to be sold.

CBG is considered “sweet gas,” so flaring is comparable to the natural gas a homeowner burns to heat their house. In its natural state, there is no odour from flared CBG.

The flaring period depends on the rate of gas flow and the proximity of pipelines. If Petrobank intends to do any flaring on our future wells, we will give nearby residents information about the potential flaring.
